Ranked Choice Voting

To modernize Pennsylvania elections by implementing ranked-choice voting, ensuring majority outcomes, enhancing voter expression, and encouraging civil campaigning.

Beginning with the 2026 general election, ranked-choice voting shall be used in all elections for [statewide/federal/municipal] offices.

Voters may rank candidates in order of preference. Votes shall be tabulated in rounds, with the lowest-ranked candidates eliminated and votes transferred until a candidate receives a majority of final-round votes.

The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall adopt regulations for ballot design, tabulation procedures, recounts, audits, and voter education.
